Agigawa Dam Reservoir Curry & Rice

Friendly Restaurant (run by a NPO) next to the Disaster Management Resource Center



Full of locally grown rice and vegetables. Chinese water spinach grown on surface of the reservoir is served in summer. ¥ 800

Nine dining establishments in Minakami Town respectively serve their unique curry sauce and toppings by dam type. ¥ 770 and over
